# World Peace Children's Drawing Contest and Exhibition 2009



## Key Dates

- Contest Starts: April 15, 2009
- Last Date to receive entries: September 30, 2009
- Final Contest: 26<sup>th</sup> October 2009

**AIM:** The aim of this Drawing Competition is to recognize creative talent of children and to listen to their vision and spontaneous suggestions on self-respect and respect for others to promote world peace.

**THEME: "World Peace"**

## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

The drawing competition is open to the students of all Indian Schools in Kuwait.

## CATEGORIES:

The competition is divided into following FOUR categories.

- Primary School (Class 1 to IV)
- Upper Primary School (Class V to VII)
- Secondary School (Class VIII to Class X)
- Senior Secondary School (Class XI and Class XII)

## WHAT TO DRAW?

The objective of this contest is to promote a culture of nonviolence and peace by raising awareness among young children about these concepts. The drawing can be your imagination supporting world peace as its main theme illustrating one or several of themes like respect for life, rejecting violence, sharing and living together, preserving planet, etc. etc. Your imagination is the limit.

## STEPS TO PARTICIPATE

1. Draw a picture in an A4 size paper based on the theme above.
2. Write your name and school information on the back of your drawing.
3. Fill out a contest entry form. If you like, add a short message to the world about how you can contribute to world peace.
4. Staple your entry form to the top of your drawing.
5. Submit your picture with the contest entry form as soon as possible, but no later than September 30, 2009 through your school or to the drawing collection centers listed in the brochure.

## ENTRY RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. Each entrant can submit only one piece of drawing.
2. The drawing should be done on a normal paper, A4 size. Art paper is preferred.
3. Entrants can draw using any of the materials – pencil, crayon, water color, acrylics or color pencils. Digital manipulation is not allowed.
4. Work that has already been shown elsewhere or accepted for another contest should not be submitted.
5. All entries must be accompanied by an official entry form (photocopy is acceptable).

6. Each school may send all entries on ONE envelope by 30th September 2009. The organizers shall arrange to collect the entries from the school.
7. As an option, students may also submit their entries to various collection points in Kuwait as designated by the organizers.

## SELECTION PROCESS

1. The contest will be held in two phases. In Phase 1, all entries will be reviewed and a maximum of 1000 short listed drawings will be selected for final contest.
2. In Phase 2, the finalists will be invited to participate in the final on-the-spot drawing contest to be held on 30th October, 2009.

## PRIZE CATEGORIES PER GROUP

1. Total of 60 winners, 15 students from each category will be chosen and awarded as follows:
  - **Excellent Award 5 per category Gold Pewter Medal**
  - **Merit Award 5 per category Silver Pewter Medal**
  - **Qualified Award 5 per category Souvenirs**
2. All short listed participants will receive participatory certificates.
3. Names of short listed participants will be announced in October and they will be notified through their schools, and also by phone or email.
4. Selected entries will be exhibited at grand finale of drawing contest to be held in October and selected entries shall also be included in the web site of KKMA.
5. The winners will be decided by a panel of judges convened by KKMA and comprised of drawing teachers and artists. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
